Team Policies

Team 8 Red teachers have set up policies that all students on the team must follow. Make sure you are familiar with these policies to help you do your best this school year. These are set up to assist each student in being successful during the school year!

Homework

To receive full credit, assignments must be turned in during the class period in which they are due. Anything not turned in during the class hour is late. Percentage received per day late is up to teacher discretion. Policies change second semester per class subject area.

Students are responsible for making up any work missed during an absence. Work that was ASSIGNED on the day of an absence will be assigned the day of return and students will be given the amount of time corresponding to the particular assignment to submit the work. Work that was DUE on the day of an absence is expected to be due the first day the student returns to school.

Tardies

Being tardy to class can greatly affect your learning. You must get to class on time in order to get the full benefit of the lesson each day. Team 8 Red defines an unexcused tardy as coming to class without a valid excuse after instruction has started. Tardies will be reported to the office and the tardy policy for the school will be in effect.

Agenda Books/ID's

Students at HMS will be issued agenda books. These books are provided to help you keep track of important dates and assignments. You must carry these agenda books with you to all of your classes.
